Greetings!

We wish to inform you that for the past few months, the DFA Office of Consular Affairs has been implementing the Appointment System for individuals applying for a passport. Under this system, a passport applicant has to call our hotline (737-1000) or log on to www.epassport.com.ph in order to be given an appointment for passport processing and enrolment.

As the system is now fully booked for the next 6 weeks, we advise would-be travelers whose passports are already expiring or have already expired to **book early for an appointment for the renewal of their passports.**

In this regard, we seek the cooperation of **Cebu Pacific** management in the **dissemination of this information** to its clients. We would also highly appreciate it if **Cebu Pacific** could include in all its advertisements the reminder that prior to booking a flight, the traveler must make sure that his or her passport is still valid for at least six months from the time of departure. Holders of passports with less than six months validity may be denied exit from the country by immigration authorities.

We look forward to your support in creating this awareness among our travelers.
